

- Respondents: Senior International Officers (leading internationalization strategy at institutions)
- One per institution
- Around 200 respondents each year in 2017 and 2020

Key Skills for SIOs

2017 Top 3

- Interpersonal skills (70%)
- Planning/visioning skills (57%)

- Intercultural competence (45%)

2017 Top 3


- Knowledge of understanding institutional culture and context (78%)

Salary Information

General Salary Information for 2017 and 2020



2017

Ranged from less than \$75,000 (7%) to above \$200,000 (20%)

Over 55% of respondents' salary ranged between \$75,000-\$150,000.

2020

Ranged from less than \$75,000 (9%) to above \$200,000 (23%).

Over 47% of respondents' salary ranged between \$75,000 and \$150,000.
