



USE OF DIGITAL MEASURES SOFTWARE TO TRACK INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITY

I received responses from two universities that are successfully using Digital Measures, besides UK: Murray State University and U of Iowa. Iowa and UK are not using it campus-wide yet – only in particular colleges.

Here are the areas that Murray State University is tracking:

1. Born and/or substantial life experience outside US (not subject to six year limitation)
2. Degree from institution outside US (not subject to six year limitation)
3. Participate in international professional development or study abroad program (includes participating in international seminars for faculty as well as teaching in MSU or consortial study abroad programs)
4. Teach course with substantial international content (includes dedicated international courses as well as integrating international content modules into other courses)
5. Conduct research on an international topic and/or with international collaborators
6. Perform international education service activities e.g., committees, grants, international student support, International Education Week planning or presentation (includes serving on international education committees, serving as departmental Study Abroad Ambassador, developing international grant opportunities, making internationally themed presentations at International Education Week, residential college events or student academic/professional organizations.

Here are the areas that UK is tracking:

- 1) Faculty place of birth and location of universities where degrees were earned
- 2) Faculty language expertise
- 3) Location (city, state, country) for all engagement/service activity
- 4) Location (city, state, country) for all conference presentations
- 5) Location (city, state, country) for all grant-funded activity

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
