2023-2024 Presidential Fellows**

Durham, NC (August 16, 2023)—The Association of International Education Administrators (AIEA) is pleased to announce that four international education leaders have been selected as the association's 2023-2024 Presidential Fellows. The AIEA Presidential Fellows program is a highly competitive mentoring initiative for senior international officers serving in the first three years of their current positions.

James (Jim) Bolender of University of San Diego; Judy Peter of Cape Peninsula University of Technology; Roopa Rawjee of Illinois State University; and Vivian Wang of The University of Tulsa were selected by a committee of their peers as this year's fellowship recipients.

AIEA Presidential Fellows are matched with experienced mentors to provide advice, consultation, and guidance on internationalization issues tailored to their institutions. Each fellow is awarded a small stipend toward a visit to their mentor's campus (circumstances permitting). This program affords participants the opportunity to observe how experienced senior international officers and their institutions address international education challenges and solve problems, to learn about national and international issues and how they affect individual campuses, and to become a member of an international network that can serve as a resource beyond the Presidential Fellows program.

Bringing extensive knowledge and experience to their roles as 2023-2024 Presidential Mentors are Jill Blondin of Virginia Commonwealth University; Harvey Charles of the University of Minnesota; Nick J. Gozik of Elon University; and Pia Wood of the University of North Texas.
