As leaders of the U.S. international exchange community, we write to commend you and thank you for your outstanding service in the U.S. Senate, and particularly for your leadership and support on issues related to international exchange programs.

Your vision and initiative in working with Senator Kennedy to create the Kennedy-Lugar Youth Exchange and Study (YES) Program has resulted in thousands of transformative exchanges over its 10-year history. YES evaluation studies show that the competitively selected young leaders from predominantly Muslim countries who come to the U.S. are forever changed by their experiences. They gain deeper understanding and appreciation of our society and people through an academic year spent living with an American family and attending an American high school. 
