# Demographics of Senior HE Leaders

## ACE College Presidents (2016)

- Men 70%; Women 30%

## ACE College Presidents (2016)

- American Indian/Alaska Native 1%
- Asian or Asian American 2%
- Black, Afro-Caribbean, or African American 8%
- Caucasian/White, 83%
- Hispanic/Latino(a) 4%
- Middle Eastern or Arab American 1%
- Multiple Races 1%

## AIEA (2017)

- Men 51%; Women 49%
- White 69%, African-American 10%, Asian 5%, and Latinx 5%

## Diversity Abroad (2019)

- 65% White; 35% Persons of Color
- 18% LGBTQ+
- 60% Millennials; 30% GenX; 85 Boomers; 2% GenZ
